Hereby we, the company Moldex-Metric AG & Co. KG, confirm that the distributed CE-marked breathing and hearing protection products are conforming to the referring EN standards and to the PPE-Regulation (EU) 2016/425.

We further confirm that all materials used for Moldex products are not known to cause irritation to the skin, injuries or allergic reactions or to have a negative influence on the health of the wearer, as long as the product is used according to its intended purpose.

All Moldex products and packaging are PVC-free.

All Moldex products are free from:

- SVHC-substances (substances of very high concern) listed in the REACH regulation.
- PFAS-substances (fluorinated substances containing at least one fully fluorinated methyl or methylene carbon atom)
- Dimethylformamide (CAS 68-12-2) and Dimethyl Fumarate (CAS 624-49-7), both different substances commonly known under the abbreviation "DMF".
- DEHP (Di-ethyl-hexyl-phthalate / CAS 117-81-7), toxic heavy metals, halogen-organic or organo-tin compounds like Tributyltin TBT (CAS 688-73-3).

All Moldex polyurethane foam earplugs are free from softeners and do not contain phthalate, which is often used to make products like this softer.

Moldex products containing activated carbon are also free from hazardous Chromium VI.
