- Lightweight fabric with ventilation holes
- Compatible with linesman chinstrap

- Suitable for 40°C washing and a maximum of 20 washes

- Made from 100% Polyester
- The neck cape is PU coated providing protection from all the elements by making the neck cape water proof.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE (HI VIS)

Slide the slits in the neck cape over the rear two clips of the helmets harness to attach to the helmet. Then refit the rear clips into the helmet shell

Make sure the neck cape is in position over the users neck before starting work, in order to provide protection

The hi-vis orange side of the neck cape should be facing outwards when in use



INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE (sun capes)

Attach left rear clip of neck cape around left harness webbing clip, repeat for right side

Attach left front clip of neck cape to the side of the sweatband. Repeat for right side

When fitting into a helmet with a chinstrap, tuck the neck cape behind the chinstrap anchors

LIMITATIONS OF USE (All neck capes)

The UPF rating only relates to the areas of skin that the neck cape covers. Protection will only be offered if the helmet and neck cape are fitted and worn correctly

The neck cape does not provide protection against reflected or scattered solar ultraviolet radiation.

For optimal skin protection the neck cape should be used in combination with other sun protective clothing

The sun protection factor performance of the neck cape may be reduced if it becomes dirty or contaminated. Washing the neck cape at higher temperatures or more than 20 times may reduce the sun protection factor.

Washing the neck cape at higher temperatures or more than 20 times may reduce the sun protection factor.

The neck cape is not designed to protect the wearer from falling masses

Any helmet subjected to an impact should be replaced immediately

Do not apply paint, solvents, adhesives, or self-adhesive labels, except in accordance with instructions from the manufacturer

The attention of users is also drawn to the dangers of modifying or removing any of the original component parts, other than as recommended by the manufacturer

The neck cape, when in contact with the skin may cause allergic reactions to susceptible individuals

If this occurs leave the hazard area, remove the cape and seek medical advice

CLEANING & MAINTENANCE (All neck capes)

The neck cape may be cleaned with soap and warm water and dried with a soft cloth

Do not clean with chemical or abrasive cleaners

The neck cape should be stored out of direct sunlight away from chemicals and extremes of temperature
